PARISH OF SPROWSTON BYELAWS

made by the Parish Council of Sprowston with respect to SPROWSTON RECREATION GROUND

4. A person shall not:
 - (a) wilfully or improperly remove or displace and board, plate, or tablet, or any support, fastening, or fitting of any board, plate or tablet used for exhibiting any notice on the ground;
 - (b) carelessly, or negligently deface, injure, or destroy any wall or fence in or enclosing the ground, or any building, barrier, railing, post, or seat, or any erection or ornament on the ground;
 - (c) wilfully, carelessly or negligently soil or defile any wall or fence in or enclosing the ground, or any building, barrier, railing, post, or seat, or any erection ornament on the ground.
5. A person shall not ride any bicycle or motor cycle or drive any motor car over the ground: Provided that this byelaw shall not be deemed to prohibit the wheeling or driving of any bicycle or motor car to the space set apart on the ground for the use of such vehicles.
6. A person shall not on the ground remove, cut, or displace and gravel, soil, turf, or plant
7. A person shall not cause or suffer any dog belonging to him or in his charge to enter or remain on the ground, unless such dog be and continue to be under proper control, and be effectually restrained from causing annoyance to any person.
